The Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences' (USU) Center for Global Health Engagement (CGHE) is a **thought leader** in the Department of Defense Global Health Engagement (DoD GHE) space and aims to provide support to the Joint Force, Combatant Commands (CCMDs) and the Services to improve, streamline, and share information on activities pertaining to the DoD GHE enterprise.

USU'S CGHE offers a range of **training** opportunities for DoD GHE practitioners and line leaders as well as interagency, civilian, and partner nation personnel. These include: Fundamentals of DoD GHE, Global Health Strategies for Security courses, CCMD workshops, and practicum and internship experiences. The Center also supports USU's curriculum, orienting interested students to DoD GHE opportunities.

CGHE provides **programmatic and knowledge management support**, which includes but is not limited to: consolidating lessons learned from the DoD GHE enterprise; providing linkages to subject matter expertise in the community, offering expert advice; assisting CCMDs in their planning, execution, and evaluation of their activities; liaising with partner nations; and supporting various coordination and synchronization mechanisms at the strategic, operational, and tactical levels.

The Center offers **assessment and evaluation** research support with the purpose of improving the effectiveness of DoD GHE programming. USU's CGHE also manages the Global Health Engagement Research Initiative, which offers grants to **GHE-related research** in support of CCMD research priorities.
