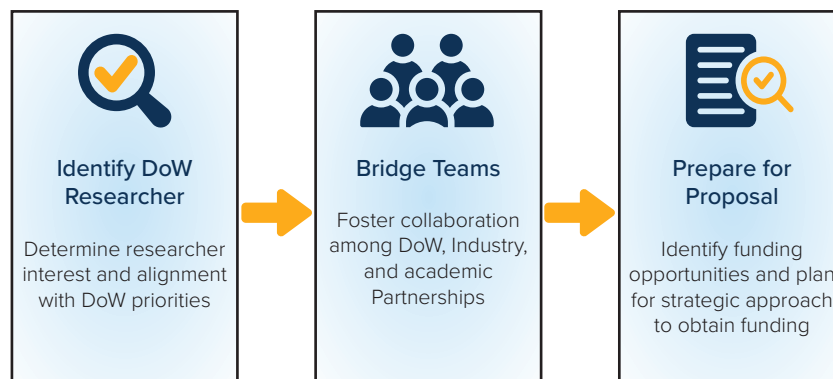




Advancing Military Medicine Partnership Process

- Compliant, error-free proposal submission

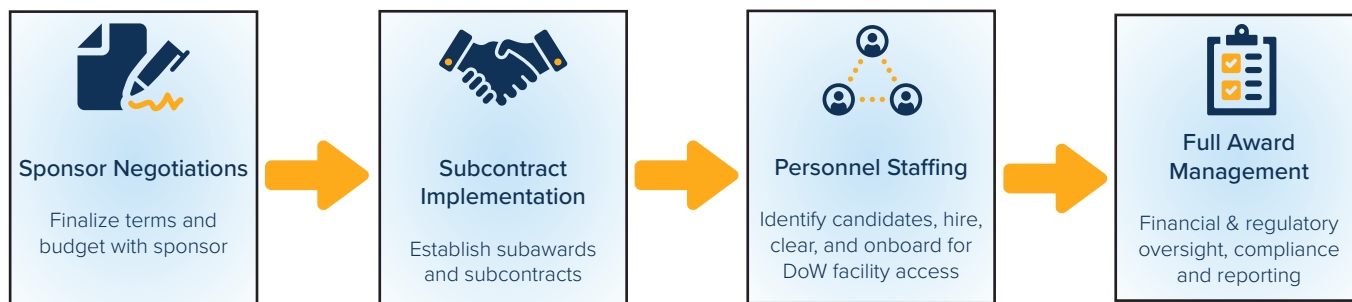
Specialized Proposal Pathways

- Consortium-based proposals when applicable (e.g., MTEC, MCDC)
- Clinical trial proposals (pilot through large, multi-site Phase III)
- SBIR/STTR and AFWERX proposals with small business partners – HJF can act as the subcontractor to the small business applicant

Award & Post-Award Management

HJF provides end-to-end post-award support for research programs, including recruiting, hiring, onboarding, and managing highly qualified research personnel. By ensuring workforce readiness, compliance, and operational continuity, HJF enables DoW investigators to focus on mission-critical research while we handle the complexities of personnel deployment and support.
